







Introducing TEXO Technologies



Biggest fight of his career for Dean Sutherland!

Undefeated Dean Sutherland takes on Englishman Louis Greene for the vacant Commonwealth super-welterweight title on 26th November at Aberdeen's Beach Ballroom.

Commenting on giving up his WBC International silver welterweight belt when he elected to step up a division, "It's not nice to give up a belt that you worked hard to get but my ambition was never just to win a WBC international title. It was to win British, Commonwealth, European and then go on to world honours."

In preparation for November's fight, Dean travelled to the iconic Wild Card gym in Los Angeles for priceless rounds of sparring this month. He rounded off his trip with a pad session with Freddie Roach, one of the world's most successful trainers who has helped guide the likes of Manny Pacquiao and Amir Khan.



"I've moved up to super-welterweight for the longevity of my career," he said. "At welterweight, especially with the WBC check weigh-ins, I was really struggling to get the most out of my body. I couldn't increase my sparring as I wasn't able to properly fuel my body. I'm only 23 and this allows me to change my training, go into a more explosive style and eat that little bit more. We're going to see more out of me at this weight as I've got a lot more energy."

Ryan Reynolds gives 6-year-old cancer fighting Blyth Spartans fan a week to remember

The Hollywood actor and Wrexham AFC owner arranged VIP treatment for Leland, six, when he travelled to Wrexham to watch their FA Cup tie against his beloved Blyth Spartans.

Blyth Spartans vice-captain JJ O'Donnell said he made the young fan 'feel like the most important person in the world'.

O'Donnell got in touch with Ryan Reynolds to share the story of Leland, a six-year-old who is fighting leukemia and in desperate need of a bone marrow transplant. Reynolds sent a video message to Leland before he led Blyth onto the pitch at Croft Park with O'Donnell. As the sides drew, Blyth travelled to North Wales for the replay a few days later.

Reynolds invited Leland to sit in the owners' box at the Racecourse Ground and has urged his 20 million followers to register to join the stem cell register in a bid to save Leland and other children who have cancer. This led to an amazing 500% increase in sign-ups.

O'Donnell, who scored as Blyth Spartans threatened to pull off a stunning comeback after being 3-0 down at the Racecourse Stadium before ultimately losing 3-2, heralded Reynolds for stepping up to help Leland.

Leland received the devastating diagnosis in September and is in urgent need of a transplant. Unfortunately, none of his family are a match.




